Reinforce our status as international financial centre

Enhance stock market liquidity, expand offshore Renminbi business, deepen Greater Bay Area (GBA) collaboration and venture into green finance. https://www.fstb.gov.hk



Accelerate growth of innovation and technology ecosystem

Set up a new Industrialisation Development Office, establish microelectronics and supercomputing centres, and a HK\$10 billion matching fund for downstream development of new industrialisation. https://www.itib.gov.hk



Develop cultural, creative and tourism industries

Set up a new Cultural and Creative Industries Development Agency, inject HK\$4.3 billion to promote film and creative industries, nurture large-scale performing arts productions as long-run performances, organise Hong Kong Fashion Design Week, and publish a new blueprint for tourism industry. https://www.cstb.gov.hk



Develop a leading international maritime & logistics centre

Publish two Action Plans on Modern Logistics Development and Maritime and Port Development Strategy, with a focus on high value-added services, modernisation, green and sustainability, and GBA collaboration. https://www.tlb.gov.hk



Use Northern Metropolis as the new engine for growth

Adopt an "industry-driven" approach, integrate deeply with Shenzhen and other GBA cities, and leverage market forces to expedite the development. https://www.nm.gov.hk



Promote new energy transport

Develop bunkering of green maritime fuel and supply of sustainable aviation fuel, formulate strategy for hydrogen development, and promote green transformation of public land transport.

Build an international hub for tertiary education

Double the admission quota of non-local students by Government-funded post-secondary institutions to 40%, and strengthen scholarship and related support to attract more overseas students, including more from ASEAN countries, to further education in Hong Kong, https://edb.gov.hk



Attract talent by a new Capital Investment Entrant Scheme

Launch the scheme in mid-2024 to give foreign nationals, Chinese nationals with permanent resident status in a foreign country, Macao and Taiwan residents the right to live in Hong Kong, provided that they have invested at least HK\$30 million in qualified assets.



Other highlights of 2023 Policy Address

"Multiple-entry visas" launched for travel to the Mainland China for eligible Hong Kong-based expatriates

From October 2023, foreign staff working in HK-registered companies can apply for "multiple-entry visas" for travelling to the Mainland China, with validity up to two years. For non-Chinese Hong Kong Permanent Residents, they can apply for "multiple-entry visa" with a validity up to five years. Prior to this measure, the validity of multiple-entry visas for foreigners working in Hong Kong usually lasted for around six months only.

Applications must be filed to the Chinese Visa Application Service Centre in Hong Kong. Please contact the centre within office hours (9 am to 12 noon, 1 pm to 4 pm (HK time), Monday to Friday) or visit its website for details.

Relaxation of entries for Vietnamese, Laotian and Nepalese





For work:

Vietnamese nationals can now apply for employment in HK under the following six talent admission schemes: (1) General Employment Policy (both employment as professionals and investment as entrepreneurs) (2) Quality Migrant Admission Scheme (3) Technology Talent Admission Scheme (4) Admission Scheme for the Second Generation of Chinese Hong Kong Permanent Residents (5) Top Talent Pass Scheme and (6) Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates covering the Greater Bay Area campus of Hong Kong universities.

For study:

Vietnamese nationals are already able to apply for admission to study in full-time accredited programmes at undergraduate or above level offered by the University Grants Committee-funded institutions.

For travel:

Vietnamese nationals meeting the following criteria may apply for multiple-journey visit visa to Hong Kong with validity up to 24 months for a stay of no more than 14 days for each journey.

- Has a genuine need to visit Hong Kong frequently; and
- He/she has made three or more trouble-free trips to two or more countries or territories (not confined to Hong Kong) in the past 36 months; or
- He/she has previously been granted permission to land in Hong Kong for employment, training, residence or study in the past 24 months.

Office for Attracting Strategic Enterprises' efforts to take off

The Office for Attracting Strategic Enterprises (OASES) is dedicated to attracting high-potential strategic enterprises from around the globe to Hong Kong. Since its establishment late last year, OASES has attracted about 30 strategic enterprises to set up businesses or expand in Hong Kong, to invest more than HK\$30 billion in total and create about 10 000 jobs in the coming years.



Pioneering battery manufacturing company Contemporary Amperex Technology Co. Limited (CATL) announced the establishment of its overseas headquarters and research and development (R&D) centre in Hong Kong.



Biopharmaceutical giant AstraZeneca announced setting up of a R&D Centre focused on cell therapy and gene therapy.

Hong Kong Talent Engage commences operation

The Hong Kong Talent Engage (HKTE) opened in October, marking another milestone of the HK Government's efforts to attract foreign talent. In 2023, over 200 000 applications have been received under various talent admission schemes, with over 120 000 approved. Around 81 000 talents have arrived in HK, far exceeding our annual target of 35 000.


