

New travel permit for non-Chinese Hong Kong permanent residents

New milestone for cross-boundary travel! Starting from July 10, non-Chinese Hong Kong permanent residents can apply for a new permit to visit Mainland China for up to 90 days for each visit, without having to apply for a separate visa. The card-type document, known as Mainland Travel Permits for Hong Kong and Macao Residents (non-Chinese Citizens), is valid for five years and not limited to nationality or industry, facilitating easier cross-boundary travel for business, tourism and family visits. Applications can be made to the China Travel Service (Hong Kong) Limited.
